

### BRENDAN Lee's return has come in a blaze of glory and at a critically busy time for East Perth.

The Royals co-captain was this week added to the WAFL State squad which is preparing to take on the NEAFL (North East Australian Football League) for the first time on Saturday, May 24.

The WAFL State team will be announced next Wednesday night.

It may be a good omen for the WA side given Lee's State game record – two games for two wins! He played in WA's win over Queensland in 2011 and then in the drought-breaking loss to Victoria last year.

The NEAFL was introduced in 2011 and is made up of clubs from Sydney, Brisbane, the Gold Coast, Canberra and the Northern Territory. It provides an elite second-tier competition for reserves sides from AFL clubs in New South Wales and Queensland, the Sydney Swans, the Greater Western Sydney Giants, the Brisbane Lions and the Gold Coast Suns.

It will be the first time a combined NEAFL side has played a representative clash. They will be coached by Daniel Archer and the squad includes former WAFL players such as Jacob Derickx (East Perth) and Ryan Brabazon (Claremont).

Twenty-six-year-old Lee could not be ignored by the State coaching panel, led by West Perth premiership coach Bill Monaghan, after just his second game back from injury.

Lee broke a finger in the final game of the preseason competition and missed the Royals first six "I knew I only had two games to impress if I was going to get a State call-up. I love State footy and feel lucky to be included in the squad," Brendan Lee.

During 2014, the Football Budget will again feature a section on WAFL memorabilia and invites you to write or email if you want more information about the football collectables you have tucked away at home.

Back in the early 1980s, there were some pretty kitsch items produced for sale.

The WAFL was taking its lead from the VFL and branching out into merchandising in a way that would never previously have been thought possible.

For a while, you could have almost any type of product with a WAFL logo on it, including your bank book (before we had bank cards, of course).You could even get your insurance organised through the WAFL.

Many of the items produced during this period turn up for sale regularly and thereby appear in this column every couple of months.

But others rarely, if ever, turn up. One such rare item is the club-themed toy mascot.

Each of these features a cuddly toy wearing a club jumper. The South Fremantle version is a Bulldog and the Perth version a Demon, while the East Perth version is simply a darkhaired man. Perhaps the key to dating them is that the West Perth version is also a man, rather than a Falcon.

I suspect these were probably made in the late 1970s and, in all my years of collecting, I've only seen the South Fremantle, East Perth, Perth and West Perth versions.

Of course, that doesn't mean they're worth a fortune.

From memory, the East Perth version that sold a few months ago – the first I had ever seen at auction - went for about \$80.

Still, it's not bad for a 1980s kids' toy.

Now, the obvious question is whether anyone can send me pictures of the East



Fremantle, Swan Districts, Claremont or Subiaco versions? Since I wrote about penants a few weeks back, have received of emails plenty different about types of penants people have kept, some of them for more than 50 years.





wrote about were those produced for grand finals, most likely by the Daily News, every year from at least as early as 1961 through to about 1977.

But, of course, there are others.

One was shown to me by an East Fremantle supporter, who had it on the wall to his house. Reading "24 in 74", it was obviously made to celebrate yet another Old Easts premiership.

But perhaps the most unusual one I have seen was celebrating a second-place finish – by South Fremantle in 1951.

The Southerners, who won the flag in 1947, 48, 50, 52, 53 and 54, were pipped by West Perth for the flag in 1951, but it didn't stop them producing a penant with the players' names on it.

It purports to also be a souvenir of the match played between South Fremantle and

the visiting Collingwood team, which was held a week after the Grand Final.

If anyone else has an interesting penant, I would love to hear from you.

The highlight of the past week's sales was undoubtedly the massive price achieved when one seller auctioned off a 1961 grand final Budget.

Though the Budget was missing a triangular piece about 3cm x 6cm from the front cover, the bidding was fierce. Two Swans supporters eventually pushed the final price to a whopping \$789.

It's a price unlikely to be achieved again. Regular readers might remember a 1965 grand final Budget, which was missing half of its front cover, sold at auction for \$275 a few weeks back. One in comparable condition sold this week for \$13.50.

Also in the past few weeks, a 1957 second semi-final Budget sold for \$18, a 1952 Budget for \$22, a 1965 Budget for \$11.50, a 1967 preliminary final Budget for \$21.55 and two 1964 Budgets sold for a combined price of just over \$20.

In other sales, a 1984 Mobil Winners sticker for East Fremantle sold for \$37 and a damaged 1934 Western Mail supplement, this time featuring West Perth, sold for \$25. A 1982 Swans membership badge sold for \$62, while a rare

1956 fixture card fetched \$20.

And, finally, a 1992 State of Origin jumper, signed by the entire team, sold for \$300.

#### **SWAN DISTRICTS V CLAREMONT**

When it seemed Tim Geappen had retired from the WAFL there was a concern about who would kick the goals for Swan Districts in 2014.

The black and whites faithful needn't have worried. Even with Geappen's decision to play on this year Swans have been well served with scorers in their seven rounds.

Ricky Cary leads the goalkicking race with 21. Matthew Jukes has 16 while Matthew Rogers has 13.

Geappen, who has marshalled the team's attacking zone, has 11.

That means the Claremont defence will be under pressure to stop the Swans goal flow.

It proved a difficult task against East Perth last round when Claremont conceded 19 goals. But the most alarming aspect to the loss was the Tigers' difficulty in making chances at the other end with just six goals from 12 scoring shots.

Luke Blackwell, Jake Murphy and Tom Taylor are getting plenty of the ball but Michael Broadbridge's men are struggling to convert the possessions into scoreboard pressure.



#### **PEEL V SOUTH FREMANTLE**

Now the Thunder will strike with anger.

Peel has been so close to victory this season. Take last Sunday. The Thunder looked to have victory in the bag before West Perth stormed home to inflict a one-point loss.

So the frustration the Mandurah club had been experiencing early in the season is starting to turn to controlled rage. And it might be South Fremantle that feels the full force in this round.

Jon Griffin has been a tower of strength in the ruck for the Thunder and if he can again give Peel the edge at stoppages then that elusive breakthrough win for 2014 might not be far away.

Some of the other Fremantle players, Sam Menegola, Tom Sheridan and Mitch Taberner, have also now settled into their new WAFL surroundings and are more confident in their football.

The Bulldogs enjoyed the bye, which might not have come at a good time considering they were building solid momentum with three wins in a row.

Adam Guglielmana, Jacob Martinez and Shaun Bewick have played key roles in the South Fremantle revival while Ben Saunders have again become a key target near the goals.



#### PERTH V EAST FREMANTLE

Expect Perth to come out firing from the first bounce in the battle with East Fremantle at Lathlain Park.

Too often this season the Demons have let their opposition get the jump on them in the first quarter.

While Perth have played strongly to challenge most of their 2014 rivals, playing catch-up football has proven too costly.

The Demons have plenty of in-form talent that can make life a headache for the Sharks.

Dene White would be very high up in the club's fairest-andbest count at this stage. Cameron Manuel showed last week why he can be important to the Perth cause and Michael Sinclair has earned high praise from the match committee for his recent efforts.

Cale Morton is starting to have an effect on the Perth defence with his penetrating kicking inside the 50m zone a damaging weapon.

Not even the return of Mark McGough has been able to lift an East Fremantle line-up that has appeared lethargic at times this season.

A team with McGough, Bradd Dalziell, Jamie McNamara, Brett Peake, Steven Dodd and last year's Sandover medallist Rory O'Brien should be performing at a higher level.






