# WAFL 200 Club's heritage mission

**FOR many years the WAFL 200 Club has gone about its work quietly acknowledging those players, coaching and umpires who reach the magical 200-game milestone.**

However, the private organisation is about to get a bit louder as it sees itself a potentially significant lobby group when it comes to football's heritage recognition at the new Burswood sports stadium.

Led by Executive Committee members George Michalczyk, Graham Moss, Ross Glendinning, Les Fong, Kasey Green, Callum Chambers and Jason Norrish, the WAFL 200 Club will work with the West Australian Football Commission to try to ensure the rich history of football in WA is transferred from the current home of football in WA, Patersons Stadium, to the new home at Burswood that is expected to be operational for the 2018 season.

"Football's future is all about the new stadium," Geoff Glass, the WAFC's General Manager Strategic Facilities told the crowd at last week's WAFL 200 Club annual induction night.

"I say that because the State Government's building of the new Perth Stadium will recast the current highly successful WA football financial model.

"The big challenge for football is not going to be whether the stadium is good enough or not. The State will take good care of that. The real challenge for all of football is to make it work so that:

- WA football can be its own master
- That the local AFL teams can be profitable in order to remain highly competitive
- That the WAFC can continue to be funded to fulfil its stewardship role and grow the game at all levels

Glass said the final agreement between football and the State in regards to management of the new stadium must cover the full operations of the venue – who derives what revenue, what costs are reasonable and who will manage the venue. He said for football to commit to play at the new \$820.7 million venue it must be convinced that overall it will be better off.

He was also adamant that the WAFL 200 Club had a critical role to play to ensure that the great stories of WA football continued to be told.

"Our interest in the past is that we are a product of it," Glass said.

"At Subiaco we have had the opportunity to incorporate football's heritage - whether it be the Sandover Medal Walk, the Bill Walker, Barry Cable or John Worsfold Rooms, the Whinnen-Dempsey Gates, the Jack Sheedy entrance, the Geoff Christian Media Centre or the Austin Roberston Jnr and Ted Tyson goal ends.

"Throughout the stadium reference is made to the legends and the great occasions because it is their exploits and those memories that transform the basic building materials of concrete and glass and plastic into a place of heightened emotions, where thrills, tension, sadness and joy are experienced and communities are created."

Those legends include WAFL 200 Club members John Campbell and John (Hooky) Doig who served in the First World War.

"In those days the seasons were much shorter, usually a 14 round season, and to reach the 200 game milestone it meant playing 14 or 15 seasons," Glass said of the individual achievements of some of football's former heroes.

"The first one to serve was John Campbell who was born in 1894 and lived until 1981. He was a brilliant ruckman/centre half forward and was renowned for his high marking and long, accurate punt kick.

"He played for North Fremantle before they disbanded and came back after the war and played

for South Fremantle, playing a total of 204 senior games, including eight games for WA.

"He enlisted in the AIF in October 1915 at the age of 21. He served three years on the Western Front, was wounded in action twice and returned to Australia in mid-1919. Three weeks after he arrived back he played his first game for South Fremantle and kicked five goals.

Hooky was a member of the famous Doig family and he played 224 games for East Fremantle between 1899 and 1912.

He was a back pocket specialist and had a reputation for his grit and bulldog determination and he played in nine premierships.

"Hooky was working as an Iron Machinist at the Midland Junction Workshops and enlisted in the AIF in June 1916 at the Blackboy Hill Camp at Greenmount. He was then 38 years of age," Glass recalled.

"He embarked from Fremantle on November 9, 1916, arrived on the Western Front in late April 1917 and just three months later was killed in action by a German shell during the Messines campaign on 31 July 1917.

"Hooky had three sons and they all went on to play league football for East Fremantle – Norman, Billy and Edgar.

"Hooky was the eldest of 17 members of the Doig family to play league football and he and his family are commemorated at the Doig Room at Patersons Stadium.

"We know that those responsible for this new project understand the importance of telling the WA sporting story at the new stadium.

"For football, whatever way you want to dissect it, the new stadium is a football stadium. It is only football that justifies building the new stadium. It is important then that the story of football be a centrepiece story in that venue.

"We look forward to working with the WAFL 200 Club to meet that challenge and ensure that the new stadium delivers on that expectation."

**During 2014, the Football Budget will again feature a section on WAFL memorabilia and invites you to write or email if you want more information about the football collectables you have tucked away at home.**

Back in 1969, football historian Dave Clement twigged that something was wrong with the WAFL's records.

At the time, "Fremantle" was recorded as having been premiers in seven of the first eight WAFL seasons.

There had actually been two different teams called Fremantle in those early years. The original Fremantle folded after the 1886 season.

The Unions Football Club changed its name to Fremantle in 1890. It folded at the end of the 1899 season.

Clement's research showed that a club called Fremantle had actually won some premierships during those seven seasons. However, he didn't think they had won seven of the first eight.

So, he wrote to the league, pointing out the error of their ways. This sparked an investigation that led the league to discover that contemporaneous records showed a side named Fremantle had only won two of the first seven flags.

But, largely because of football politics, the records would not officially change for another 16 years.

Which, belatedly, brings me to this week's somewhat unusual featured item.

When the league finally decided, in its centenary year of 1985, that the league's records and honour board should be changed, they invited Clement to league headquarters to personally unscrew the offending brass name plates from the board.

They were replaced with the correct plates, which showed that Rovers had won the premierships of 1885 and 1891, while Unions had won in 1887, 1888 and 1889. One of the Fremantle brass plates was moved to 1886, which had incorrectly been recorded as a premiership year for Unions. The other four were discarded.

And, this week, some 29 years after its removal, one of these brass plates was shown to me.

I have no idea how to put a value on such an item. In fact, I doubt it's worth much at all. But, much like the finial from Fremantle Oval's Victoria Pavilion that featured in this column a few weeks ago, it's a fantastic piece of WAFL history.



Last week, I wrote about the availability of a reproduced 1960s service station transfer and warned readers to ensure they knew exactly what they were buying.



The modern re-printed version of the Swan Districts Golden Fleece transfer was being sold for just \$4.

It's nice to be able to report that the warning, and photo, prompted John to dig through his cupboards and dig out his original 1960s transfers

John wanted to know how much the four transfers – for Swan Districts, Subiaco, South Fremantle and East Fremantle – might be worth.

I had little hesitation in telling him they would almost certainly fetch \$400.

The service station transfers are particularly attractive and sought-after, especially given many of them would have ended up on bedroom mirrors and car windows.

The key, as with any WAFL collectable, is to ensure it's kept in good nick.

After a slow couple of weeks, there were a few reasonable WAFL collectables on offer this week.



Regular readers might remember a Joondalup Falcons watch that featured in this column a few weeks ago. One appeared at auction this week and sold for the rather disappointing price of \$20.50.

There were also a couple of badges on offer. A 1956 Claremont membership badge sold for the rather high price of \$70, while a 1953 Subiaco badge sold for \$52.

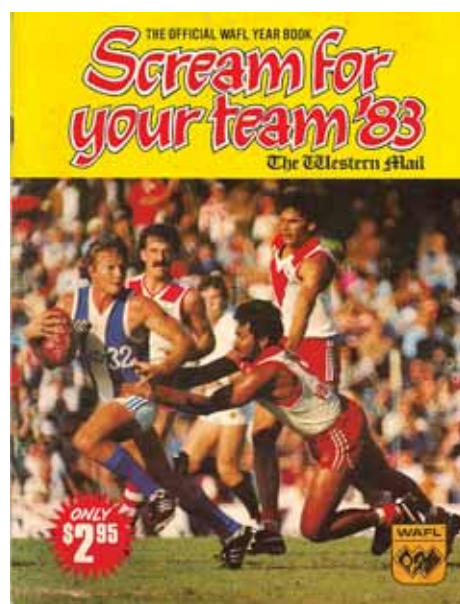
A Subiaco jumper worn by Dwayne Lamb in the early 1980s sold for just \$22, while a 1993 East Perth pre-season competition jumper sold for \$72.

There were plenty of 1980s Budgets available at auction, though most fetched only a few dollars. A 1983 Western Mail football book, called "Scream For Your Team" fetched \$26.



Finally, my thanks go to Allan, who contacted me last week after I again asked for help to fill the holes in my collection of club annual reports.

## Falcons District 'Sock it to Sarcoma'

**THE West Perth Football District will host a football festival to coincide with the Kalin Foley Cup at Heathridge Park this Sunday, August 24 to raise funds and awareness for Sarcoma Research.**

Kalin Foley was in Year 7 in 2012 when he was diagnosed with a rare soft tissue paediatric sarcoma called Rhabdomyosarcoma.

He has since undergone intensive chemotherapy and his treatment continues.

After hosting the Kalin Foley Cup in 2012 and 2013, the Foley Family along with Ocean Ridge JFC and Wanneroo JFC have joined forces with the West Perth Football District and WA Football Commission to raise the profile of the event in 2014.

In addition to expecting a great game of footy, Ocean Ridge will put on a festival of events including cake stalls, raffles, a silent auction, bouncy castles and face painting.

Football clubs across the District are encouraged to follow the lead of West Perth's League team and support the event by wearing odd socks on the day and offering a gold coin donation to be collected by Team Managers.

Players are encouraged to wear one of their team socks accompanied by an odd sock on the other foot – joining the "Sock it to Sarcoma" theme.

The feature match between Kalin's Year 9 football team, Wanneroo, and Ocean Ridge will bounce down at 1pm, with Kalin to walk through a guard of honour pre-match and toss the coin.

The Kalin Foley Cup will be presented at the conclusion of the match.

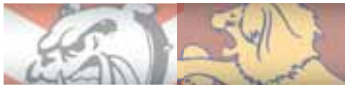
Before the newcomers take on the powerhouse in the Division 1 preliminary final, Joondalup Falcons will face Swan Districts in the Division 2 preliminary final.

The Royals will use this encounter to finetune their operation for the premiership tilt.

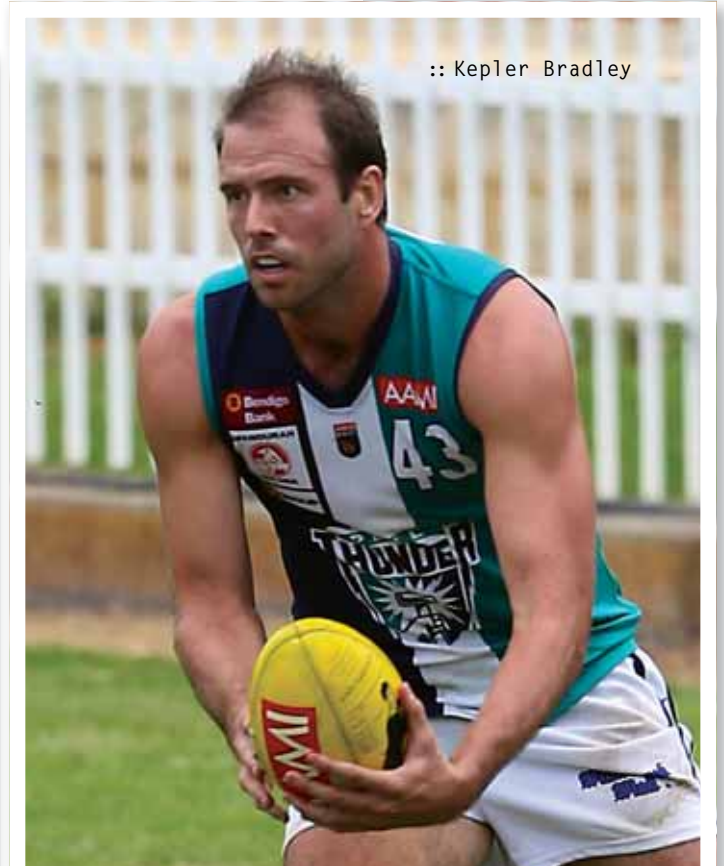
Their 28-goal haul last round suggests they're already running hot.

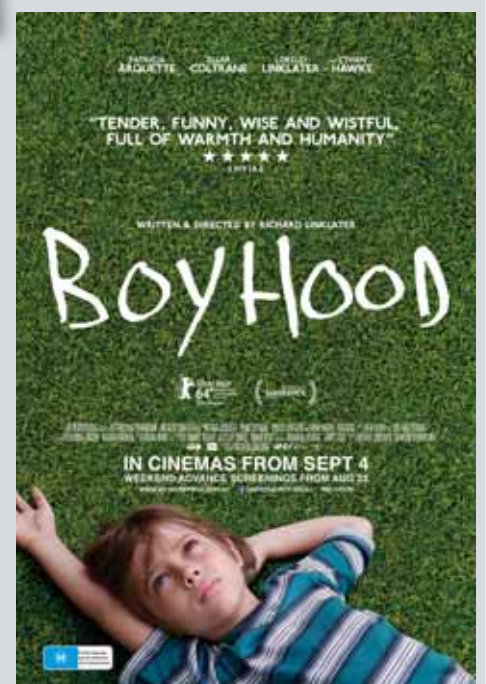

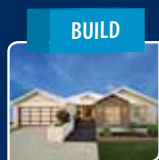

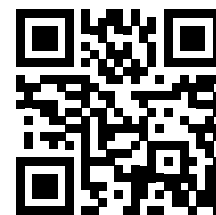
