But coach Cam Shepherd would also like to guide one of his most loyal servants to a couple of individual achievements during 2015.

Shepherd will witness another in round three when Brendon Jones runs on to Bendigo Bank Stadium – the 200th time the midfielder has done so at WAFL league level.

The next week the Thunder meet Perth at Lathlain Park and it will mark Jones' 100th appearance for the Mandurah club – coincidentally against a Demons jumper he wore 101 times.

The milestones are the mark of a successful State league career. Players don't last that long if they don't have the talent and nous.

However, Shepherd wants two more honours for Jones before the career comes to an end.

"Brendon Jones has been a great warrior for Perth and Peel but the one thing he hasn't had is the joy of being part of finals," Shepherd said.

"He has a real passion for that and, hopefully, at some stage we can get him there. "He has never been able to play State football despite winning three fairest and bests at two clubs. If his form continues to be strong we'd like to think he'd be considered strongly for the State side."

A strong endorsement on the longevity of a 28-year-old who made his debut with Perth in 2004 and almost quit the competition at the end of the 2013 season.

The legacy of playing on-ball on the big WAFL grounds and plans to start a family twins had prompted retirement thoughts.

Peel gave Jones four months of think time. And lured by the attraction of helping out Fremantle in their alignment with the Thunder Jones played on and was club champion last September.

He was also made captain and Shepherd said he had been a vitally important link in the Peel playing group.

"After Brendon and Leroy (Jetta) our next (most experienced) player is a 35-gamer," Shepherd said.


"There is a big gap and Brendon bears that leadership responsibility very well.

"The Fremantle boys that come along are looking for leadership as well. At the weekend five of them were teenagers and they were finding their feet in the game.

"So we really appreciate Brendon's contribution."

Thunder fans can be confident Jones can play a further part in blending the AFL and WAFL talent into the club's first finals contender.

"We think he's got more footy in him even beyond this year," Shepherd said.

PALLE PTAR

Over in Melbourne, there are plenty of collectors who chase after programs from matches played overseas by VFL and AFL clubs.

The earliest of these was in 1963 when about 1500 spectators turned out to watch Melbourne narrowly defeat Geelong at the Hickam air force field in Honolulu. The same teams met again about a week later in San Francisco.

Then there was a series of games in 1967 played by the touring Galahs team, which was made up of footballers from across Australia. These were played under the rules of the Gaelic game.


But what most of the Melbourne-based collectors don't know is two WAFL teams were next to play football overseas.

The visit of East Perth and Subiaco to New Delhi in October 1969 resulted in two matches being played at the National Sports Stadium.

The Maroons, who finished fourth in 1969, upset the WAFL runners-up in the first match. But the Royals fought back in the second to record an easy victory.

And, of course, there were a couple of items produced that may interest collectors.

One of these was the 75-page match program, which was produced by the India Tourism Development Corporation Ltd of New Delhi and features more advertisements than you ever thought it possible to fit into a single magazine.





I'm told one of these sold to an East Perth collector a few years ago for about \$300, but I have not seen one sold at auction.

The other piece of memorabilia I have seen from this trip is East Perth's tour itinerary.

At 28 pages, it's actually a really interesting record of the trip, providing every detail, including the aircraft seating plan and the hotel room allocation for New

Delhi and stopovers in Mumbai, Bangkok, Hong Kong and Singapore.

But what I have not seen is a Subiaco tour itinerary. Can any old Maroons remember whether one was produced for the trip?

Having discussed this tour with a couple of Royals players, it would seem there was a bit of bad feeling between the two clubs after Mal Brown knocked some of Graham Dearle's teeth out in the first match.

That doesn't sound like something Brownie would do, does it?

On the subject of tour itineraries, there have been other overseas itineraries, though these largely relate to leisure tours, rather than playing tours.

This one from East Fremantle dates to the 1970s and was for a players' tour of South-East Asia.

There are still plenty of summer sales that I haven't been able to report during the first two weeks of the season.

One of the best was for a West Perth carry bag, which appears to date to the early 1970s. It sold for \$255 at auction in February, attracting spirited bids from four potential buyers.

Interestingly, a zip-up West Perth bag with the same logo sold privately for \$250 a few years back. The material used in the two bags are exactly the same.

Carry bags like these are extremely popular and generally sell for anywhere between \$150 and \$300. Over the summer, I was also



shown an East Fremantle bag that would have a few Sharks collectors salivating. It featured the phrase "Go East Fremantle with Gola" on the side. Gola is a British sporting goods company and I must admit having no memory of the company making a push into Western Australia.

Another unusual collectable to come up for sale was a South Fremantle towel, made by the Australian company Dickies sometime in the 1970s.

The seller said the previous owner had been given it when he trained at South Fremantle in the early 1970s. It was in great condition and was sold privately for \$50. As always, I'm now wondering whether these towels were made for the other seven clubs?

Now that the season is a few weeks old, the usual requests from collectors have started to mount up in the WAFL Collectables email inbox.

The first was from Dean, of Melbourne, who collects drinking glasses from all football teams, including WAFL clubs. There are six known sets of WAFL glasses, plus countless glasses produced by the clubs themselves, so please get in touch if you can help Dean with any of these.

Gerry, of Balcatta is chasing East Perth yearbooks and has a pretty impressive collection already. A lifelong Royals supporter, he is also very keen on a rare East Perth bobblehead doll, should anyone be lucky enough to have a few lying around.

And I'm still looking for most of the South Fremantle annual reports from the 1970s and 1980s, if anyone can help.




Farewell Steve Bazzo

REMEMBERED for his dashing style and flowing locks as well as just being a "good bloke", football suffered a great loss last week with the passing of Steve Bazzo.

The 45-year-old passed away after a typically brave battle with cancer. He leaves behind wife Kylie, daughter Kameron and son Rhett.

Bazzo, who hailed from Carey Park, was bestowed life membership at two WAFL clubs, Swan Districts and Peel Thunder and also spent time with West Perth.



He made his league debut in 1995 with the Black Ducks, where he went on to play 158 games and kick 82 goals. In 1996 he headed to the Falcons and played 14 games (including one in 1997) before heading South to join Peel Thunder in their inaugural WAFL season, playing his first game in Round 9, 1997 and his last in 2000. He was made a Life Member of the Thunder in 2007.

Kylie Bazzo was the first female CEO of a WAFL club when she took the reigns at Peel Thunder in 2001.

"Steve had recently returned to the club this year as a development coach with our under 16's," Peel President John Ditchburn wrote on the club's website this week.

"Steve will be sorely missed by all at the club and within the football community."

Female coaches on the rise

The West Australian Football Commission hosted a Level 1 Coaching Course for females on Sunday, March 22, which resulted in 34 new coaches being add to the 25 that received their Level 1 accreditations last year.

In 2014, female football participation in WA increased by 78 percent with just over 33,500 participants making up 18 percent of total participation. To support this growth, the WAFC developed strategies to engage more female coaches and last year, the first Female Only Level 1 Coaching Course was held.

The course was subsidised and delivered to players within the WAWFL and Youth Girls Competition resulting in 25 new female Level 1 coaches. The event was such a success that it was repeated again this year and the attendance numbers were even more impressive, with 34 new female coaches of various ages and from various backgrounds taking part.

These were broken down into aspiring coaches from NAB AFL Auskick, Junior Girls, Kirby Bentley Cup, Youth Girls, WAWFL and Schools.

Level 3 coach Michelle Cowan shared her knowledge and journey when she presented at the course and said she was excited to be in a room filled with passionate female coaches.

"In 2000 I completed my Level 1 Coaching accreditation and I was the only female in the room," she said.

"When I attended my Level 3 coaching course I was one of three females, so it is exciting to see so many females now getting involved."

WAFC Female Football Co-ordinator Allana Dickie said she was pleased with the outcomes achieved for female coaches over the last two years.

"The strategy to subsidise the course for the players has had incredible outcomes, strengthening the partnership between the junior and senior clubs, which will also support the transition and retention of players," Dickie said.

"It was also very positive to see a number of teachers and mums attend the course, which we would like to continue to encourage and expand on in the future.

"The benefits of hosting the course in a female only environment gave the women the confidence to attend with no previous experience as everyone was at the same level."
