# STATE COACH spins a wide web

***Marc Webb was a classy midfielder as a player with Perth and Subiaco. Now he has become a master juggler.***

And his ability to keep everything moving in unison will be the key to success for Claremont and the WA team this season.

No WAFL coach has had a busier schedule. Webb's main job in 2013 was to mentor Claremont's quest for consecutive State league flags. Just to add a degree of difficulty to the task, he must also guide the Tigers' defence of their Foxtel Cup crown.

But there is a third prong to Webb's campaign as the coach of the WAFL combination to take on the mighty VFL in Northam next month. That is in addition to running his own financial company.

While his work with Claremont is nothing new, adding the State team responsibilities has forced Webb to be a very clever time manager.

However, a chat with one of his WA assistant coaches has given the Simpson medallist the confidence he can keep all the balls in the air and steer the Black Swans to an improved performance against a combination that has proven highly problematic for the WAFL.

"I've looked to get as much help as I can," said Webb as he poured over the names of the initial squad announced this week.

"One of my assistants is (East Perth coach) Brian Dawson, who has coached the State team before so on our first selection night I sat down to pick his brains on how to handle the role.

"I've got some good people around me so I can outsource some of the duties and Claremont has the beauty of a first-round bye in the Foxtel Cup so that helps a bit."

Joining Webb on the WA team match committee are Dawson, former Royals player Adam Pickering, ex-Fremantle, Western Bulldogs and Claremont midfielder Brad Wira and Tigers official Wayne Orsi, who will serve as chairman of selectors.

While State duty has normally been viewed as an honour reserved for the best 22 players in the competition, the selection team has adopted the approach of picking a line-up capable of knocking off the Big V, not necessarily trying to manage a combination of individuals.

Webb is in another unique position of being a WA coach with State team playing experience. He was part of the squad that was humbled by the VFL in Melbourne in 2007. WA then lost to the Vics by 55 points in 2010.

And he believed in some previous attempts the Black Swans might have taken the wrong strategy into interstate competition.

"We will be concentrating on getting the right balance," Webb said.

"Some may ask why a certain in-form player isn't in the team but it might be the top-10 players in the competition are inside on-ballers and we can't have all of them.

"So while we want in-form players we want to make sure we have people to cover all areas."

Although rookie-listed AFL players are available for selection under interstate rules, it is highly unlikely either WA or Victoria will include any.

An injury to Jeremy McGovern (Claremont) has ruled him out of the match while Subiaco's Callum Sinclair was recently elevated to West Coast's senior list.

And the VFL has indicated it wants to showcase local talent and will shy away from the AFL-registered players.

However, Webb said he wouldn't overlook former national league stars if they deserved a spot and believed Perth's Paul Bevan, Paul Bower from Peel, East Perth ruckman Paul Johnson and Andrew Strijk (West Perth) would be considered for duty.

WA are planning four training sessions before the interstate battle and both teams will travel to Northam the day before the match.

## CLAREMONT V WEST PERTH

### Claremont Oval

It's the battle of the two WAFL heavyweights of 2013.

West Perth and Claremont are both undefeated – the only teams in the competition to still have that honour after four matches – and each will want to use the other as a yardstick by which to gauge their season development.

Injuries have hurt the Tigers in recent weeks with Luke Blackwell and Jeremy McGovern sidelined by lower leg wounds.

But Marc Webb's combination has plenty of firepower. And if Ian Richardson, Anton Hamp and Chad Jones can get their hands on the ball they loom as strong offensive weapons.

The fixture throws up a juicy personal battle between Tiger big man Mark Seaby and his former teammate Chris Keunen, who has been a pillar of strength to West Perth.

If Keunen can bring Rohan Kerr, Matt Guadagnin and Mark Hutchings into the contest, the Falcons have the talent to trouble the double defending premiers.

The Tigers have, at times, started first quarters slowly while adjusting to opposition defensive tactics, giving the Falcons an opportunity to create a buffer on the scoreboard by attacking hard and early.

## EAST FREMANTLE V EAST PERTH

### East Fremantle Oval

Victory is the aim for every team but the manner in which East Fremantle claimed the points over Perth in last Sunday will have shaken a few at Shark Park during the week.

However, the two-point win over Perth in controversial circumstances in round five will also give some young Sharks the confidence to back their talents no matter the team's predicament.

And some fresh-faced players have been important to East Fremantle in recent weeks.

Ryan Lester-Smith has adopted some of the traits of father Neil, a former East Fremantle champion, by proving to be a reliable goal-kicker and ruckman Cam Symonds has been effective up forward and on the ball.

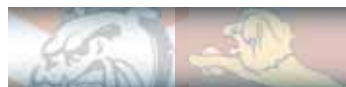
Symonds will have his hands full against an East Perth team stacked with plenty of tall timber.

## SOUTH FREMANTLE V SUBIACO

### Fremantle Oval

South Fremantle has been competitive despite not winning a game, though that could change against Subiaco which sits just one game above the Bulldogs on the premiership ladder.

The shorthanded Bulldogs were once again unable to execute down the stretch last week despite an improved second half and let Swan Districts claim the points.

But South Fremantle coach Paul Hasleby is confident there has been improvement in his line-up over the first four rounds. Ryan Cook has shown solid leadership and Mitch Banner has impressed in midfield.

And the central corridor will be where the Bulldogs will have to produce their best defensive efforts. Toby Bairstow and an improving Haiden Schloithe will be crucial in that region.

Stopping the influence of Subiaco's Jason Bristow will be the key to any South Fremantle strategy. Bristow's passion to win the ball in congestion has set up plenty of the Lions' forward presses this season.

Though the Lions were held to their lowest score against Claremont last week, scoring their first goal midway through the third quarter, they can manufacture a raft of goal opportunities when their on-ballers dominate.

The return of Fremantle squad member Vic Michie after he was relegated to the reserves for disciplinary reasons last week will boost the home team.

A strong start could just be the most important aspect to Peel's challenge in round six.

Like Forrest Gump's box of chocolates it is hard to know what to expect from the black and whites in 2013.

There have been strong performances, such as in the win over East Fremantle in round one, the disappointing return against Claremont, and some indifferent form in the triumph over South Fremantle last week.

Yet Swans can play some of the most exciting football in the competition. Tony Notte can pull down marks from anywhere, Kirk Ugle has bobbed up as a valuable goal kicker and rookie Charlie Cameron has given glimpses of his talents.

However, there is something about Bendigo Bank Stadium that brings opposition teams back to the fore and if Peel can capitalise on the local conditions its first league win of the year mightn't be far away.

Mitch Green is in line to play his 50th match for the Thunder.

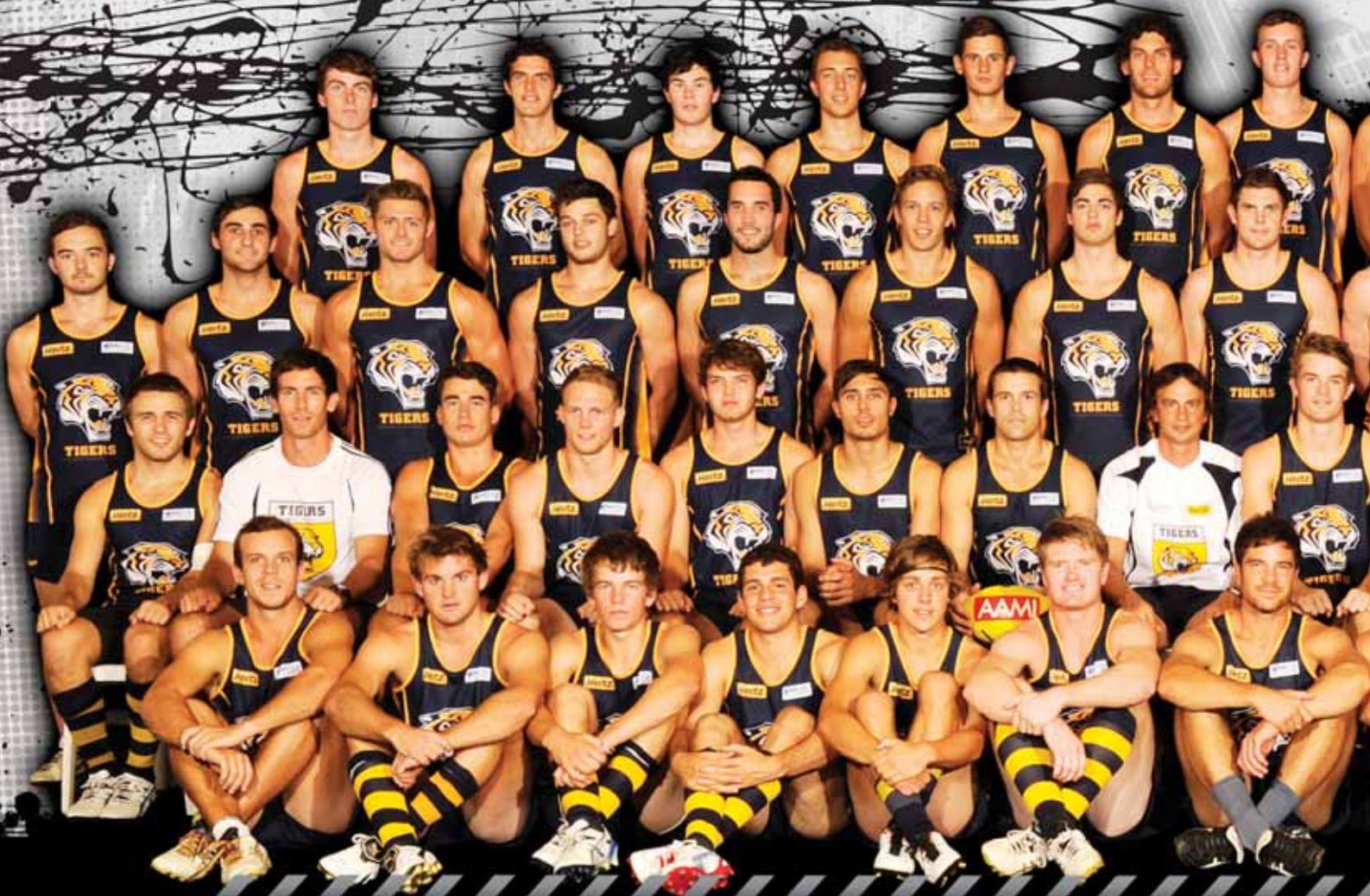

## Exciting steps towards Swan Districts development

**A recent agreement between LandCorp, the Town of Bassendean, Swan Districts Football Club and the West Australian Football Commission has opened the door to revitalising Bassendean's Town Centre and the much-loved Swan Districts Football Club.**

The agreement, defined in a Memorandum of Understanding, will re-open discussions around the redevelopment of the Bassendean Town Centre.

Mayor of the Town of Bassendean John Gangell said this was the first step in examining the potential to develop previously underutilized land located on the west side of Steel Blue Oval.

"Although it is early days, the agreement between all parties and the community to consider the many development options in and around Bassendean Oval is exciting," Gangell said.

"For some time now we have been examining the unrealized potential for the town centre.

"The MOU offers a degree of certainty around the planning and delivery once a final decision is made about the scope of the development."

The Government, through the land development agency LandCorp, believes this project has the potential to improve facilities for current residents as well as those moving to the area.

Swan Districts chief executive Tom Bottrell said the project will be driven by a commitment to achieve strong social, environment and economic outcomes.

"While we expect the redevelopment of the oval to accommodate an increasing population with changing needs and provide more business and residential opportunities, of equal importance is the preservation and enhancement of local amenity inclusive of the football oval and its historical aesthetics. The ability to add value to a treasured asset in the Oval, while retaining the much loved character of its surrounds, is very exciting."

WA Football Commission director of facilities Geoff Glass said the partnership was fantastic news for Swan Districts and the code.

"This proposal follows the great work already being done in partnership with LandCorp at Claremont Football Club and will create another exciting opportunity for an historic WAFL club," Glass said.

"We are looking forward to working closely with LandCorp, the Town of Bassendean and Swan Districts Football Club on this revitalisation project to ensure WAFL clubs continue to be at the core of our community."

LandCorp chief executive Ross Holt said the objective is to meet the targets of the Metropolitan Planning Strategy – 'Directions 2031 and Beyond' – which aims to deliver a greater choice of housing and much improved facilities for areas like Bassendean in and around the metropolitan area.

"The idea is to build on what is already there and fill in some of the development gaps where improvement may be required.

"Whilst a clear vision for the project is yet to be confirmed, early thinking suggests the work may include sporting, retail, commercial, office, civic, residential, education and recreation within an accessible and well-connected, urban-scaled townscape, comprising a major activity centre and related urban villages based on "Main Street" principles."

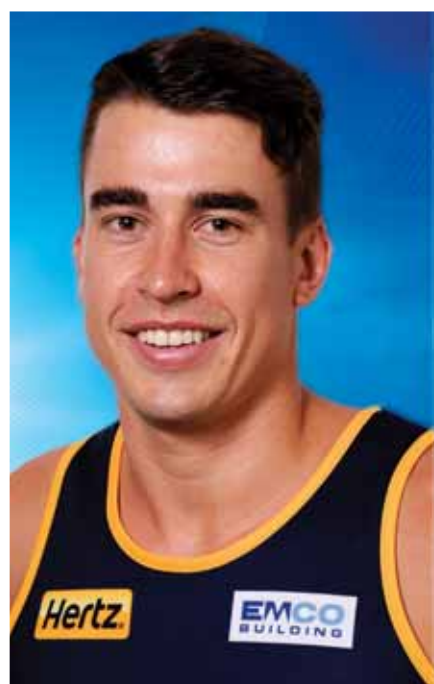

## Spotlight on spirit of the laws 2013

***In an effort to achieve consistency and accuracy in Umpire decision making, there is an emphasis on understanding the spirit of the laws (i.e. the philosophies underlying the laws) and officiating according to the spirit of these laws.***

Umpires are coached weekly and on match day in accordance with these laws. For coaching purposes, the laws have been categorised into five main areas. In this edition we take a closer look at the final two areas surrounding ruck contests and 50m penalties.

### Law in focus:

#### Ruck Contests

*"The player whose sole objective is to contest the ruck shall be permitted to do so."*

- Illegal contact includes players who push, bump, block, hold or make high contact.
- Where there is incidental contact in a ruck contest when the ball is the sole objective (eyes on the ball), play on will result.

#### 50 Metre Penalty

*"After a mark or free kick has been awarded, a 50 metre penalty will be awarded against the opposing team which unduly delays the play or abuses an umpire."*

An undue delay of the play includes:

- Cribbing the mark.
- Not returning the ball directly to a player after they have been awarded a mark or free kick.
- Unduly holding up an opponent after that player has marked the ball.
- A player not involved in a marking contest holds a player who has marked the ball or has been awarded a free kick.
- Remaining in or entering the protected area.

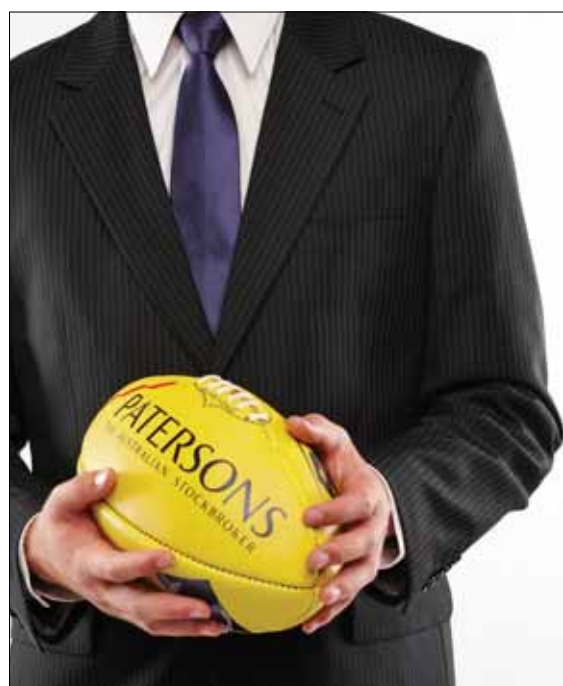
Expanding the event allows all club players to have direct participation in contributing to the success of the day, and increases the generation of donations from players' family, friends and work colleagues.

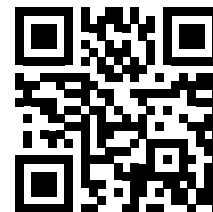
